### Athens High School Laptop Loan Agreement

The Athens Area School District is proud to offer our latest advancement to the one-to-one laptop program within our school district. Beginning in the 2021-2022 school year we will be allowing our Athens Area High School students the option to take their devices with them after school. Along with the required completion of the acceptable laptop use policy, students who wish to use the device outside of the school district are required to participate in our self-insurance program. The program will offer the following benefits.

- Every student participating will receive a carrying bag for their laptop.
- Any student that participates for all four years of high school will receive ownership their assigned laptop upon graduation.
  - Current Sophomores-Seniors can choose to purchase their current laptop at an attractive discount.
- Insurance fee will cover the first incident of repair.
  - o 2<sup>nd</sup> incident is covered with a \$25 deductible
  - o 3<sup>rd</sup> incident is covered with a \$50 deductible
  - o 4<sup>th</sup> incident family is responsible for cost of repair or replacement of device.
- In extreme cases of negligence (loss or intentional abuse) by the student, a \$100 maximum charge for the first incident of damage may be assessed

# Parent Responsibilities and Terms.

#### As a parent, I will:

- Review the district's acceptable use policy with my child.
- Discuss appropriate internet usage with my child.
- Immediately report any damage or loss of the laptop to the school district.
- Not attempt to alter or reconfigure the laptop, except for connecting it to a home wireless connection.
- Not attempt to make any repairs to the laptop.
- Ensure that my child brings the laptop, fully charged, to school every day.
- Ensure that my child is properly utilizing the provided protective carrying bag.
- Return the laptop to the school district should my child withdraw from the Athens Area School District.

# Student Responsibilities and Terms.

#### As a student I will:

- Review the district's acceptable use policy with my parent or guardian.
- Adhere to the terms of the acceptable use policy of the Athens Area School District.
- Ensure that the laptop is fully charged every morning and bring it to school.
- Properly care for the device and utilize the provided carrying case for safe transport.
- Not attempt to alter or reconfigure the laptop, except for connecting it to a home wireless connection.
- Not attempt to make any repairs to the laptop.
- Immediately report any damage or loss of the laptop to the High School office.
- Not remove or attempt to remove any labeling or identification tags on the laptop or attempt to deface it with writing or decorations.

#### Rates:

The Athens Area School District is doing its best to keep costs at a minimum, while providing the best resources possible. We understand that contributions for some families may be more difficult. As such, we have developed a system that provides our families with a discount if they have more than one child in the high school. It also provides those families with Free or Reduced lunch qualifications eligible to receive an extra discount. The contribution for insurance coverage for the Athens Area High School Microsoft Windows based laptops is as follows.
