

AASD Live Streaming Notes / Expectations 2020-2021

- Students in Grades K-2 will use Seesaw.
The Seesaw app has been loaded on the student's device and their sign-in has already been set up for the students. Simply click or tap on the Seesaw app.

(The link for Seesaw can also be found in the Students tab on the AASD website.)
- Students in Grades 3-12 will use Schoology.
The link for Schoology can be found on the AASD website under the Students tab. The teacher(s) will provide the class code to join the appropriate classes.

*Please see the attached directions for those students that are new to using Schoology.
- Zoom links for live stream sessions/class periods will be posted in Seesaw or Schoology.
- A schedule for live stream sessions will be posted in Seesaw or Schoology by 8:00am on the first school day each week. Please be sure to check for any schedule changes that may be posted.
- If school is delayed due to inclement weather, an adjusted time schedule will be provided in Seesaw or Schoology. Early dismissals for weather will be communicated through a phone call and the social media.
- Additional instructional materials may be provided by your child's teacher to support their instruction. These materials may be picked up at your child's normally assigned school on the 1st and 3rd Monday between 12:00 and 2:30pm and 5:00-7:00pm. Any materials that need to be returned to the school can be returned on those same dates and times.
- Live streaming will not take place on days that the classroom teacher is absent. A message will be posted on Seesaw or Schoology when a teacher is absent. Assignments to be completed for that day will also be posted. Students are expected to complete and submit these assignments according to the due provided by the teacher.
- Attendance will be taken by your child's teacher for all scheduled live stream sessions.
- Students will receive regularly AASD progress reports and report cards.

- The same grading policies will apply for live stream students as apply for students in the traditional school setting.
- High School student grades will count towards AASD class rank and GPA.
- Please do not use the live stream option as a means to critique the instructional practices of teachers within the Athens Area School District. Recordings of lessons are expected to be used solely as instructional resources. Recordings will be available after Monday, September 14th. Recordings will be stored in Seesaw and Schoology.
- Students may participate in extracurricular activities at their normally assigned building.
