

AASD Reopening Phases

<p>In- Person Instruction</p> <p><i>minimal to moderate</i> community/school transmission</p>	<p>In this phase, the district will offer three (3) options to students and families.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. In-person instruction five (5) days per week. 2. Remote learning with students attending AASD classes via livestreaming. 3. WOLA – teacher facilitated self-paced online academy for students. <p><i>See AASD learning options chart for detailed information about each option</i></p> <p>NOTE: Students will be required to wear face coverings inside the school, inside the classroom, and throughout the day when six (6) ft. of social distancing is not feasible. The majority of classrooms will require face coverings due to limited size. Mask breaks will be provided to students throughout the day.</p> <p>Students must follow the requirements of wearing a face covering and social distancing.</p>
<p>Hybrid Alternate</p> <p><i>substantial, controlled</i> community/school transmission</p>	<p>In-person instruction will be modified for students. Students will receive two (2) days per week of in-person instruction and three (3) days per week of remote learning.</p> <p>The district will still offer additional learning options to students and parents in addition to in-person staggered schedule.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Remote learning with students attending AASD classes via livestreaming. 2. WOLA – teacher facilitated self-paced online academy for students. <p>The district will deliver an alternate school schedule that will stagger student attendance. This will reduce the number of students in classrooms by approximately 50%. With smaller class sizes, students will be able to socially distance inside of classrooms and face coverings may be removed.</p> <p>Students will still be required to social distance and wear face coverings in any circumstance where social distancing is not possible.</p>
<p>AASD Remote Learning</p> <p><i>substantial, uncontrolled</i> community/school transmission</p>	<p>During the remote learning phase schools will be closed for in-person and all instruction will be provided via remote learning, digital and non-digital. All students will be assigned a device.</p> <p>Instruction will be delivered by AASD teachers using the district’s learning management platforms - K-2 Seesaw and 3-12 Schoology.</p>
