Wildcat Students and Parents,

We are returning to class tomorrow, Tuesday, January 4th, 2022. While we were all hoping for an end to the pandemic, it's obvious that COVID-19 is having a significant impact on our community and schools. We need to partner more than ever to make sure we are able to keep our schools open for in-person learning.

The AASD Health and Safety plan follows the CDC recommendations for Isolation/Quarantining for COVID-19 positive individuals and all identified close contacts. On Dec. 27th, 2021, the CDC updated those guidelines, see the bottom of this letter for that updated guidance.

I urge families to keep their child(ren) at home when they are exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19. I also implore families to not send their children to school if an individual in the household is COVID-19 positive, exhibiting symptoms and was exposed to a COVID-19 positive individual, or awaiting a COVID-19 test result. If our school buildings reach a COVID-19 case count of 5% within a school building, we may be required to close our schools and move to remote learning for a period of time. If you have questions about whether you should send your child to school, please call your buildings principal.
